FIRE IN THE 3TH WARD.—Last night at eleven o'clock, a fire broke out in a glass house owned, as we were informed, by Mr. John Agnew, and situated on the corner of Carson and Etna sts. At half-past eleven, when we left, there was little prospect of saving anything. The lateness of the hour precludes our learning any of the particulars. The glass house was used by Messrs. Wormser & Co., whose warehouse is on Market street, as a vial and bottle factory. The works have not been in operation for about three weeks and the fire is supposed to have been the work of an incendiary.
